## POLICY REGARDING DOCUMENTATION REQUIRED TO OBTAIN A PROVISIONAL VETERINARY LICENSE

It is the policy of the Texas Board of Veterinary Medical Examiners that all applicants for a provisional veterinary license must submit, to the Board, the following items in addition to the designated application form:

- 1. a letter of good standing from each jurisdiction in which the applicant is currently licensed or has been previously licensed;
- 2. a certified copy of the applicant's veterinary school transcript including a graduation date;
- 3. a certified copy of the applicant's birth certificate;
- 4. a certified report from the official reporting service verifying that the applicant passed the national examination or the NAVLE, subject to a petition by the applicant for an exception to this requirement in accordance with §571.11(b)(2); and
- 5. an application fee in an amount set by the Board.
